Clay Order	<ul> <li>Orders for Clay will be placed over the phone by participating members to Baileys. Members will have one week to call and place an order; then there will be 1-1.5 weeks to pick it up. (Members will be provided with a one-week range of when the order will be available at Waterbrook).</li> <li>Vehicle size: We will know how much clay before pickup and have a week to plan to organize appropriate vehicle size. Empty Bowls	<ul> <li>Electricity bill increased 150% since opening.</li> <li>Depending on how many Empty Bowl firings the CCCG may cover some firing utility expenses related to empty bowls. We are waiting to see what the utility bill is with 3 kilns running to understand what expenses of firing will be.</li> <li>There will be separate firing shelves for empty bowls to track kiln load quantities.</li> </ul>
